The mv S.A. Agulhas will depart from Cape Town on 19 October 2007 at 14:00, to transport the construction group and cargo to Marion Island.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS

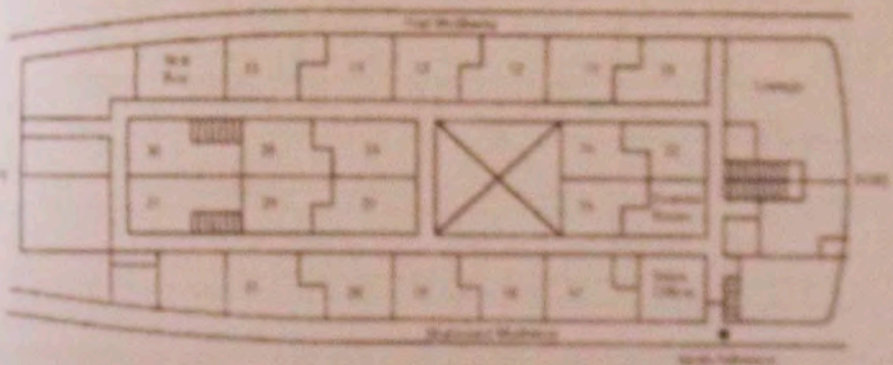
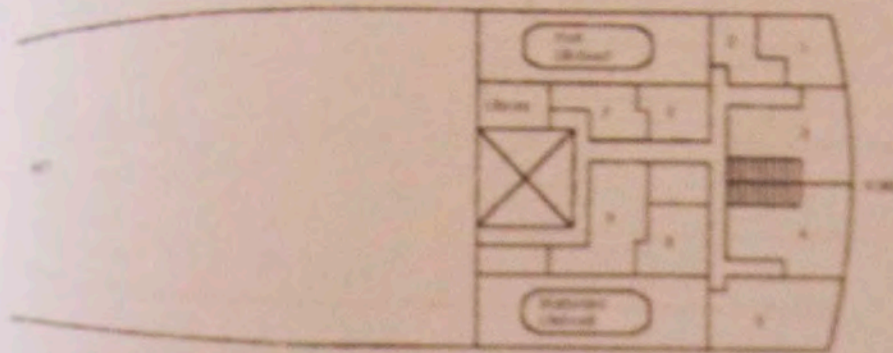
