REVISED SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: MV SA AGULHAS: MARION ISLAND VOYAGE 134: 8 MARCH – 10 MAY 2007

1. The mv S.A. Agulhas will depart from Cape Town harbour on 8 March 2007 at 14:00, to transport the construction group and cargo to Marion Island.

2. The voyage schedule (Annexure A), passenger list (Annexure B) and cabin allocations (Annexure C) are attached for your information and further attention.

3. TRAVEL DOCUMENTS

All persons accompanying the voyage must be in possession of valid passport and residence or visitor's permits where applicable. The afore-mentioned documents must be handed to the ship's Catering Officer (Purser) at least 24 hours prior to departure. Persons not complying with this request will be responsible for arranging their own customs and immigration clearance. All passport details are to be forwarded to Adriaan Dreyer on or before 12 February 2007 to arrange for immigration clearance. Those participants, whose details have not been received, will be responsible for their own immigration/customs clearance. The ship will not be delayed for these purposes.

4. GENERAL

There are various rules and regulations pertaining to the code of conduct on board the mv S.A. Agulhas and base stations. These are explained in the attached document (Annexure G) "Organisation of Operations and Conduct of Participants in the South African Antarctic Programme".

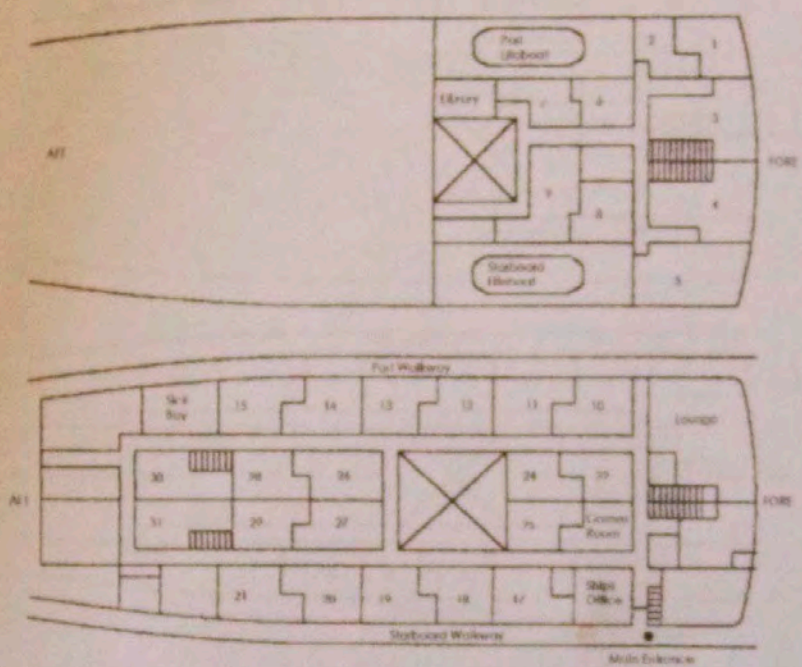
