MINISTERS have the honour to refer to Executive Council Minute No. 877 dated the 29th January, 1948, extending approval for the issue of a Proclamation to govern whaling operations during the 1947 - 1948 season and to inform His Excellency the Governor-General that as the International Bureau for Whaling Statistics has determined the 31st day of March, 1948, as the date upon which the quota of blue whale units for the current whaling season in the antarctic shall be deemed to have been attained, it is incumbent upon the Union Government now to take steps to prohibit the taking of Baleen Whales in the Antarctic after that date.

MINISTERS accordingly have the honour to recommend that His Excellency the Governor-General may be pleased, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by Section 4 of the Sea Fisheries Act, 1940 (Act No. 10 of 1940), to approve of the issue of a Proclamation in terms of the accompanying draft in English and Afrikaans.



day of April, 1948" in paragraph (2) of the said Proclamation.




